

General sales terms:

1. The present order is complete and executable only following approval of the supplying firm.
2. No matter what terms of delivery have been established, the merchandise travels at the buyer's risk and therefore eventual insurance of the merchandise is the buyer's responsibility.
3. Execution of the present order depends upon the availability and possibility of obtaining raw materials and secondary product.
4. the supplying firm is not responsible for failure to supply quantities for causes beyond its control.
5. Discounts are neither accepted nor granted on samples.
6. Claims made 10 days from receipt of merchandise will not be accepted.
7. Only payments made directly to the supplying firm will be recognized as valid. No person is authorized to collect payment on our behalf unless specifically authorized to do in writing.
8. The delivery terms are indicative, and the supplying firm, upon sending notice to the buyer, has the right to extend the delivery date at any time up to a maximum of 90 days, should, for reasons beyond its control, difficulties arise in the supplying of raw materials and secondary items; the buyer, therefore, cannot cancel the order unless cancellation is accepted by the supplying firm.
9. returns will not be accepted unless authorized in advance and shipped carriage paid.
10. A 15 interest, calculated at an annual rate, will be applied on delayed payments.
11. Delayed payment may result in the cancellation or suspension of current order.
12. Until the merchandise has been regularly and entirely paid for, it remains the property of the supplying firm.
13. Should payment fail to be made according to the established and confirmed terms, the supplying firm will have the right to issue a draft, including added expenses, on the buyer, to be paid at sight.
14. the buyer in forwarding this order hereby declares to fully accept, without any reservations or exceptions, the above stated conditions, and terms here specified, of sale, even if the present orders is unsigned.
15. for any controversy which may arise, the court of Fermo (Ascoli Piceno), Italy, will have jurisdiction regardless of where the present order has been stipulated.
